

Mitigate the spread of Covid 19

Based on circular letter Rector of Universitas Islam Indonesia No. 1048/Rek/10/SP/III/2020



Class implementation

- 1. The regular class is conducted by using an online platform e.g., Google Classroom, Zoom or other system starting from March 16, 2020, to April 15, 2020. The duration of online learning can be extended by taking into account the latest situation of the outbreaks. The Midterm Examination scheduled on April 16, can be conducted as a take-home exam.
- 2. Applying strict protocols for certain classes that cannot be carried out by using online platforms such as practicums, fieldworks, work practices, medical skills activities and other activities (such as Pharmacist Oaths). The protocols will include temperature checking, hand sanitizing, limiting the physical contact (such as handshaking), and restricting general lectures that invite lecturers/experts from other universities, cities or countries.

Postponing the programs or activities

- 3. The programs or activities involving many people or other parties outside Universitas Islam Indonesia (such as seminars/conferences, workshops, and general lectures), are suspended from March 16, 2020, until the Covid-19 pandemic abates. If the programs or activities cannot be suspended for specific reasons, strict protocols must be applied.
- Postponing Graduation Ceremony Period IV academic year 2019/2020, which is scheduled on April 18, 2020. Participants of Graduation Ceremony Period IV 2019/2020 can take the certificate starting from April 18, 2020, at the Directorate of Academic Services (*Direktorat Layanan Akademik/DLA*), Universitas Islam Indonesia.
 We look forward to announcing the graduation date by considering the current situation of the outbreak.

Local and international mobility

- 5. Restricting the staffs/lectures to travel abroad or out of town.
- 6. Imposing strict protocols for international guests, including quarantine and cancellation of meetings if necessary.

Self-care and environmental health

- 7. Increasing the disease prevention efforts by maintaining environmental hygiene, practicing a healthy lifestyle, avoiding physical contact, and providing supporting facilities, such as hand sanitizers and maskers.
- 8. If you have fever, cough and breathing difficulty (which refers to the symptoms of Covid-19), please seek medical attention and call in advance. Stay at home if you feel unwell. Permission requests can be submitted to the Academic Administration Division (for students) or Division of General and Household Administration (for administrative staffs) or Chair of the Department (for lecturers) or the supervisor.
- 9. Appealing to all faculty members, education staff, and students to avoid large gathering spaces (such as shopping centers, cafes, or shared workspaces).
- 10. While doing all the prevention endeavors, all faculty members, academic staff, and students are encouraged to be spiritually connected to Allah SWT, by improving the quality and quantity of the good deeds including almsgiving.
