Understanding Indonesian Economy with NXU, China Nanjing Xiaozhuang University (NXU) China is a partner of the Universitas Islam Indonesia (UII) since the signing of the MoU on February 19, 2014. NXU and UII have successfully conducted Immersion Program: Understanding Indonesian Economy in July 2019. This joint initiative program, participated by 19 NXU students and 2 lecturers, provided opportunities for NXU students to learn about Indonesian Economy, with the activities including lecturing, company visit and cultural activity.

English Immersion Program with Santichon Islamic School, Bangkok, Thailand Ull and Santichon Islamic School (SIS) Bangkok, Thailand has signed an agreement in 2018. Through this partnership, Ull and SIS has agreed to conduct an English Immersion for SIS students at Ull with the duration of one month every year. The program consists of intensive English classes for high school students, cultural activities to introduce Indonesian traditional culture, especially Javanese culture, and field trips to some attractive places around Yogyakarta city.

Indonesian Coffee Story: Exploring the Diversity of Indonesian Coffee from Gayo-Aceh to Merapi-Yogyakarta" was conducted on 10-21 September 2018 corporated by Ull, University of Muhammadiyah Sumatera Utara, the Ministry of Research, Technology, and Higher Education, Republic of Indonesia and Passage to ASEAN University Networks.. This two week summer program consisted of indoor and outdoor lectures about the current practice of coffee plantation and coffee shop business in Aceh, Medan, and Yogyakarta. Participants obtained 3 credits and certificate from host universities after joining indoor and outdoor class with lectures and practitioners with international reputation and finishing assessment such as individual and group presentation, daily blogs report, and video documentation. Participants also stayed with the local coffee farmers during site visit and live-in activities. The program were a partial scholarship awarded to twenty five participants from Malaysia, Vietnam, Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, dan Swedia.

Understanding Islam in Indonesia with Flinders University, Australia Understanding Islam in Indonesia is a collaboration which was initiated by Flinders University and Universitas Islam Indonesia in 2015. This program is a short term mobility project which offered an opportunity for the participants to observe, experience and learn about many aspects of Islam that can be discovered by studying and staying in Yogyakarta, Indonesia. This programs consisted of thematic lectures, field trips and short internships.
