

Department of Architecture, Faculty of Civil Engineering and Planning (FTSP), Universitas Islam Indonesia (UII) is organizing an international workshop and exhibition called ""Learning from Mangunwijaya"", in collaboration with the Encounters with Southeast Asian Modernism from sbca GmbH, Germany and the Indonesian Architectural Museum Foundation Yayasan Museum Arsitektur Indonesia. The event is scheduled to take place in Yogyakarta from July 21 to August 3, 2024, and is aimed at contributing to the success of UII's Strategic Goal of increasing benefits through expanding network reach. This series of programs was funded largely by the German Federal Foreign Office.

In the 'Learning from Mangunwijaya, the International Workshop and Exhibition' program, the Department of Architecture FTSP UII has invited a number of partner universities, namely, Bauhaus Universität-Weimar, Germany, Kalasalingam Academy of Research and Education, India, Rangsit University, Thailand, Universiti Malaya, Malaysia, National University of Singapore, Singapore, University of Indonesia, and Gadjah Mada University, Yogyakarta. There are 34 students from the partner universities who have confirmed their attendance, accompanied by their lecturers.

The International Intensive Course in Islamic Psychology (IICIP) serves at least two purposes:

First, this is one of the form of our commitment to develop Islamic Psychology by teaching it to wider audience outside the department of Psychology, Universitas Islam Indonesia. Through its Center for the Studies of Islamic Psychology (founded in 2018) we are committed to become one of the centers of excellence at the Department of Psychology, through our research, teachings, publication as well as extended learning programs for the communities in order to spread the benefit of the knowledge of Islamic Psychology. This year will mark the 6th IICIP and we will once again conduct the International Intensive Course on Islamic Psychology as online sessions of lectures and workshop. Similar to the previous IICIP, we will be supported by the Department of Psychology and International Association of Muslim Psychologists (IAMP). This year we also involve IIUCP- Forum in Indonesia as our collaborator, so that this program can benefit more students and psychology academic from wider areas in Indonesia and in other countries.

Secondly, by inviting Indonesian and international students to Universitas Islam Indonesia to join the Intensive course in Islamic Psychology, we hope to strengthen the worldwide network of experts and students. It is thought that this will enable the students with interest in Islamic Psychology to see that the opportunities to contribute to its development are wide open.

The program has been running since 2019 (supported by the Department of Psychology - UII, IIIT and IAMP) starting with the first IICIP on UII campus. During the pandemic, we organized it in 2020, 2021 and 2022 through an online platform. This event is in line with mission of many world Muslim scholars of conducting and disseminating educational research that is serving the Integration of knowledge and religion (Islam).
